INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

Applicants must meet both requirements below in order to be considered for a scholarship award:

Requirement 1:

Be baptized or confirmed at Holy Trinity Burlington OR

Be baptized or confirmed elsewhere with a transfer to Holy Trinity Burlington

AND

to have communed at Holy Trinity Burlington during the past year.

Requirement 2:

- 1. Agree to accept the award in person during worship between July 1 and August 31.**

Applications will ONLY be considered if all required documents are submitted on time.

The applicant is responsible for submitting all documents as listed below.

→ Submit:

- A completed cover sheet for each scholarship requested.
- One (1) copy of proof of acceptance to the appropriate accredited educational program.
- If applying for the Sadlier Scholarship: a typed 200-word essay discussing the personal impact of a book the applicant read during the past year.
- If applying for the Waldman Scholarship: a typed summary of one's previous three years of reading.
- If applying for the Sadlier, Shewell, Stinson, and Waldman Scholarships: a typed 200-word personal statement demonstrating one's concern for Christ and His Church through personal, active, and consistent involvement in HTELC during the previous four years.
- If applying for the Immendorf Scholarship: a typed paragraph describing your Christian activities during the past two years.
- If applying for the Andersen Scholarship: a typed personal statement describing one's professional plans and goals.
